Town of Augusta Town Law 2 of 2016

A Local Law of the Town of Augusta Amending the Town of Augusta Zoning Ordinance to impose a penalty for failure to obtain a building permit under Article 9 Local Law of 1982

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Augusta as follows:

Section I Purpose

To provide for the efficient administration and enforcement of the Town of Augusta's Zoning Ordinance which requires the application for and issuance of a building permit before certain improvements are made to real property in the Town of Augusta for the safety, welfare, and best interest of the citizens of the Town of Augusta and thus to help insure compliance with the request of obtaining a building permit for the Codes Enforcement Officer prior to making improvements as more particularly set forth in the Town of Augusta Zoning Ordinance

Section II Amendment

Article 9 Section 6 of the Town of Augusta Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

In the event any work is commenced prior to the issuance of a permit pursuant to the Town of Augusta Zoning Ordinance the permit fees shall be twice the amount of the fee established by the Town Board from time to time by resolution. In the event no fee is required for a permit and the work has been commenced without a permit a Fifty Dollar (\$50.00) penalty shall be imposed. Work shall stop pending payment of the fee and no certificate of occupancy shall be provided until all fees/penalties have been paid in full

Section III Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect upon filling with the office of the Secretary of State
